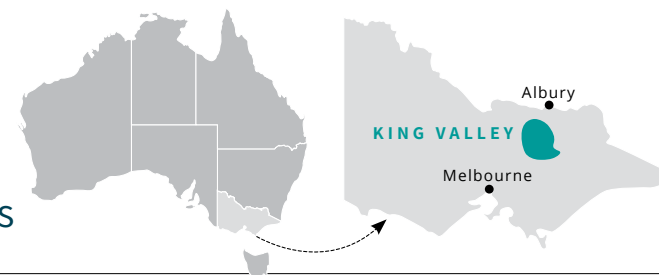


# King Valley Prosecco Road

The glass-fronted tasting room is a magnificent place to discover the prosecco range.
- **Brown Brothers**  
The Brown family is fourth-generation winemaker with enduring heritage, offering a number of prosecco experiences.

Sample superb prosecco in this striking subterranean cellar door before tucking into a shared platter.
